

# 2010 Senior Video

## Parents and Seniors:

I wanted to get this letter out to you before the holidays so that if you are going through photos at Christmas you can be deciding on what you want in our Senior Video. We will be asking you to submit these photographs after school resumes in January and have a deadline of getting these turned in by the end of February. Scott Miller, father of Jake Miller, has agreed to do our video and I will be assisting him in getting the photographs together and keeping them organized for a safe return to you. In order for this process to run smoothly and to ensure that you get your photographs back safely there are some submission guidelines that I have outlined below. **We will be collecting hundreds of pictures so following these guidelines is extremely important. Please take time to read them and if you have any questions you may email me.**

1) You may submit 3 individual pictures of your Senior. These pictures can be of any age or grade. That is your choice. When I say “individual” I mean only of your Senior. Please **IN PENCIL** write on the back of the photo or attach a sticky note to each picture with the number 1, 2, or 3, number 1 being the one that we can guarantee to be in the video and 3 being if room allows. We have over 250 Seniors so depending on how many people submit pictures will determine how many photos each Senior can have in the video. We don’t want the video to be 2 hours long. The Video Committee will decide after all is turned in exactly how many photos each Senior will be allowed. I would rather have them all up front and maybe not use one than to have to come back and ask for more. Also please write your Senior’s full name on the back of the photo in pencil. Place the pictures in an envelope with the following printed on the front: Individual Photos, Senior Name and contact information (phone #).

2) You may also submit 3 additional photos of your Senior with friends or groups. Again, in pencil, please mark the back 1, 2, or 3. These pictures will follow the same guidelines as the individual photos however, the photos in this category will be placed in the video under the discretion of the Video Committee. The reason for this is we do not want duplication of photos in the video. For instance if a group of friends each submit the same or similar photo we would have duplication. These pictures should go in an envelope with the following information on the front: Group Photos, Senior Name and phone number.

3) Please have your Senior fill out the attached questionnaire and enclose it in the envelope marked Individual. I would like to incorporate this somehow in the video but not sure if we will be able to or not. Again I would like to have this information so we don’t have to ask for it later if we do decide to use it.

4) Turn your envelopes into the front office at BHHS. Agnes Hejtmanek has agreed to accept them and I will pick them up from her.

5) You may submit your pictures on a CD or via email. I have a separate email address set up for this. Just make sure you include all of the information that has been requested. The email

6) All pictures will be returned on the night of Pro Grad. They will be placed in the Senior's bag. If for some reason you want your pictures back earlier contact me and I will arrange to get them to you.

7) We will also include pictures of events throughout the year in the video. If your Senior is involved in extra-curricular activities (sports, choir, band, clubs, etc.) please be taking pictures. I have a few events covered but NOT ALL. If parents are not taking pictures then we will not have that activity covered. It is just not possible for me to cover everything. So to be clear, if your Senior is involved in golf (for example only) and you want to guarantee that sport to be in the video please take the pictures and forward them to me by the deadline. Obviously some activities will not occur until after the deadline but we will still accept them and fit them into the video...exp. baseball, softball, YPS, Prom, etc. **Neither the Video Committee nor anyone associated with Project Graduation will be held responsible for an event being left out.**

**To recap:** You may begin submitting pictures after Christmas break and the deadline for submission will be February 28, 2010. You may submit them via email or turn them into the main office at the high school using the envelopes, or on a CD. **Please write only in pencil on the pictures themselves. Label the pictures 1 - 3. With 1 being the guaranteed one you want in the video, 2 the next, and 3 the final choice. My thoughts are now that we will be able to do at least 2 and hopefully if space permits the 3<sup>rd</sup> but it IS NOT GUARANTEED!** We will do our best to get as many pictures as we can in the video without making it too lengthy and we will maintain fairness throughout the process. With your cooperation this will be possible.

**I will send out another reminder via email after school begins in January. It will be your responsibility to submit your pictures. If I don't have your pictures submitted by February 28<sup>th</sup> I will assume you are not submitting any and move on with the video. I will communicate via email from this point on. If you are not receiving the Project Grad emails please let me know and I will make sure you are put on our contact list.**
